How much do they cost?



All of our programs operate on sliding-scale fee to accommodate the financial needs of the people and places we work with. This means schools who can, pay more (with larger budgets), so that schools who cannot afford our programs are covered! Sweet, right? We also take into account: materials (including: promotional materials to help you spread the word!), travel (geographic location), number of facilitators required, and stipends for our speakers. To the extent that we are physically able to provide the service, cost will never be a determining factor in terms of who we do and do not work with.
